The camp will be held at Otterbein University's Athletic Campus (180 Center St., Westerville, OH 43081). Otterbein University is located in Westerville, a suburb just north of Columbus and is easily accessed from both Interstate 71 and Interstate 270.

For MapQuest or GPS purposes use the following address: 180 Center St., Westerville, OH 43081. Parking for this event can be found in the lots surrounding the Memorial Football Stadium located on Center St.

The facilities of Otterbein are grass fields and an indoor field house complete with Mondo flooring. Student-athletes should wear sneakers to the facility to be used in the event the camp was to move inside, and bring football shoes for the grass.

The Otterbein training staff has volunteered to provide full training facilities and supervision.

The camp goes on rain or shine. Please dress accordingly.

You do not need to wear/bring pads or helmets, but mouthguards are recommended. QB's can bring your own ball. No other position should bring a ball. Please wear sunscreen.

Check-in begins at 7:30 a.m. at the Clements Recreation Center, north of the stadium, and camp begins at 9 a.m. Please make sure to allow ample time for travel and check-in.

**If you use an inhaler or have allergies/asthma requiring medication you must bring your medication with you. Please label it with your name and phone number. The medical staff will brief you before the start of camp.**

Please bring a bag lunch and drink. Water will be available throughout the day.
